- **OPEN** to students (junior and seniors) in all career and technical programs
- **NO cost or fee's** for participating in the program, uniforms and text provided
- **NO military obligation:** However, placement credit may be awarded (higher rank and pay) after graduation to those individuals who choose to enter any branch of the military
- **MAY** be used for physical education or social studies credit (Not all Affiliate High Schools will allow this)
- **One** class period a day, an academic elective, not a Career and Technical program
- **JROTC UNIFORMS** are worn one day each week (approximately 25 times a year)
- **COLLEGE** credit option
- **OPTIONAL** Summer Camp
- **Program** Develops leadership potential, appreciation for healthy lifestyle and self confidence
